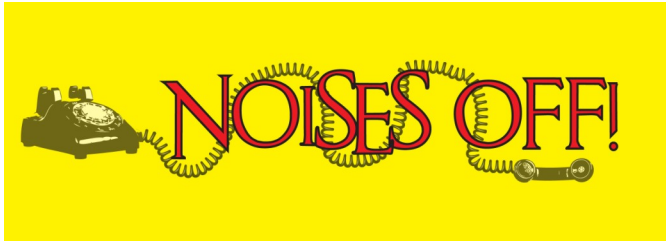

The Pinckney Players present “Noises Off!”

The Pinckney Players are proud to announce the cast of their Spring production, Michael Frayn’s “Noises Off”, to be performed **One Weekend Only**, April 15-16, 2011, at the Jane Tasch Performing Arts Theatre in Pinckney. Mark your calendars now! **Show times are 7:30 p.m. on April 15th and April 16th with a matinee at 2:00 p.m. on April 16th.** This hilarious comedy depicts the onstage and backstage antics of a second-rate acting troupe touring in an awful sex farce. “Nothing On” is the title of this play-within-a-play that the director of the theatre company is desperately trying to get into production, despite the best efforts of the cast, the crew, and Lady Luck. You will follow the production from final rehearsals, through opening night and onto the tour.

Directed by veteran Lynn Wilde and produced by Ann Langford, “Noises Off” includes a very talented cast from all over the Livingston County area. Fred Kahle will be featured as Lloyd Dallas, the temperamental director of the theatre company. Eric Dockus and Ruth Tureff play Frederick Fellows and Belinda Blair and are seen as Phillip and Flavia Brent who live out of the country to avoid paying taxes. They must be careful to avoid being caught by Inland Revenue. New comer, Nick Stoddard, plays the role of Garry LeJeune, the stuttering actor who portrays Roger, a real estate agent attempting to rent Flavia and Phillip’s home, but using it for his own personal benefit. Laura Mandernack will portray Dotty Otley, a forgetful fading star who plays Mrs. Clackett, the housekeeper for the Brent’s home. Dotty is dating Garry, though she attempts to make him jealous by meeting with Frederick. Kristen Ocelnik will be seen as Brooke Ashton, a young inexperienced actress who pays no attention to the other performers, either onstage or backstage. She in turn plays Vicky, who works for Inland Revenue and is trying to woo Roger. Thom Mellen is seen as Selsdon Mowbray, an elderly alcoholic who hides his bottles on stage and plays the burglar who breaks into the Brent’s home. The cast is completed by Chris Burns who stars as Tim Algood, the over-worked stage manager and Tiffany Cogswell who is seen as Poppy Norton-Taylor, his emotional and over-sensitive assistant.

Are you confused yet? This show is a glorious display of slamming doors, breaking windows, and seventeen false entrances, while listening to seventy-three flubbed lines, forty-six miscues, twenty-two double entendres, and a million laughs (all while trying to find a missing plate of sardines)! As with any group of actors forced to work closely together for any length of time, romance and arguments are bound to break out. Sometimes the best action occurs behind the scenes!

You won’t want to miss this uproarious comedy in three acts. It is perfect for an adult evening out with family or friends and is recommended for ages 13+. Pamela Campau Scholarship for the Arts

Pam was a part of the Pinckney Players' family for many years. In addition to being a talented actress who could sing and dance, she was also a gifted painter who for many years painted our Pinckney Players' sets. She touched so many of us with her endless smile and positive outlook on life. In May 2009, in her memory, we started the Scholarship for the Arts. In the second year of the Pinckney Players' Scholarship for the Arts, two (2) scholarships will be awarded to high school seniors who intend to pursue a career related to acting. A \$250 college scholarship will be presented to each high school senior that has been selected in accordance with the following rules:

- Each year the Pinckney Players will accept up to 30 qualified applicants on a first come basis. Deadline for applications will be March 1.
- Applicant must be a high school senior who plans to attend a Michigan college or university full-time with a major or minor in theatre and have an acceptance letter.
- Applicant must provide their most recent transcripts showing certification of a GPA of 2.75 or better
- Applicant must have two letters of recommendation from any source along with an essay of one hundred words or less stating how being a part of a theatre group has affected their life.
- If not a Livingston county resident, the applicant must be sponsored by a current Pinckney Player member.
- In the event of a tie between two applicants for either scholarship, an audition will be required.

The winners will be contacted by phone and/or e-mail by May 1. The scholarship certificates will be given to the high school of the recipients so that they can be presented as part of the schools' scheduled honors assemblies. A check subsequently will be issued to the college or university of the recipient(s). The Campau family will be notified of the winners.

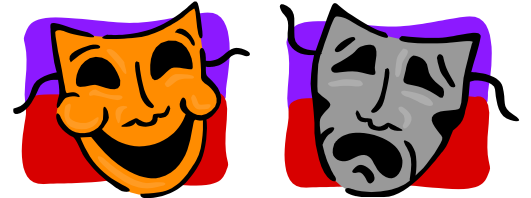
