That boring husband refuses to take the blame when she shoots her lover and ends up in prison, pending hanging. There she meets seductive nightclub performer turned double-murderess, Velma Kelly (**Kelly Hayner**) and smooth-talking lawyer Billy Flynn (**Jeff Jackowski**), and pulls every trick in the book to get off death row and out into the limelight of the roaring 20's. With help from Matron Mama Morton (**Lynn Wilde Concannon**), both Roxie and Velma vie for the spot as Illinois most-famed murderess, but there's only room for one legend "That's Chicago."

CHICAGO includes a very talented cast from all over the Livingston County area. The music & lyrics by Kander & Ebb make it as captivating as any of the musical heavyweights. The Wizard of Oz was a 1902 musical extravaganza based on “The Wonderful Wizard of Oz” by L. Frank Baum, which was originally published in 1900, and the well-known 1939 film adaptation. The story chronicles the adventures of a young girl named Dorothy in the Land of Oz, after being swept away from her Kansas farm in a cyclone. The novel is one of the best-known stories in American popular culture and has been widely translated. Its initial success, and the success of the 1902 Broadway musical, led to Baum’s writing 13 more Oz books. The original book has been in the public domain in the United States since 1956.

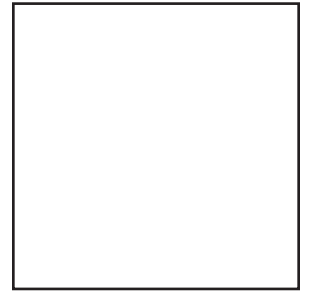
Parts Include: 8 men: Six older gentlemen (30-50+ years old), two younger (20-30 years old)
