

## **WE'RE BACK! SWEET DELILAH RECAP**



After a year with no shows, we returned to the beautiful Jane Tasch Theater in April with a wonderful production of "The Sweet Delilah Swim Club". The show had many challenges due to COVID restrictions. The school was not yet open, so we held auditions in Shalom Church, and rehearsals in the basement of Dr. Brad Rondeau's Grand River Dental office in Brighton.

The five women in the club, close friends from their college swim days, gathered on the outer banks of North Carolina every summer to re-connect. The audience witnessed life changes and challenges over a period of 23 years. COVID restrictions also limited our audience size, and seating was organized to allow social distancing between groups. But the 300+ patrons who attended the production laughed and cried their way through this heartfelt portrayal of friendship among women.

The ensemble cast included names many will recognize from previous shows: Lynn Hosenev, Laura Mandernack, Lynn Wilde, Candace Chapman, and Dawn Allman. The show was directed by Kate Murphy and produced by Ann Langford. A new viewing option was introduced for the show to accommodate those unable to come or uncomfortable about coming into the theater; we were able to stream one Saturday night performance online. The streaming option was a success in spite of some technical difficulties, and we hope to continue this option for future performances.
